Customs clearance takes 20 working days to 4 weeks from receipt of all requirements before final delivery.  Containerized cargo must be palletized failing which the shipment will be denied entry to the country. This regulation is valid for all shipments arriving in Nigerian ports as from 11 July 2017 (consult your destination agent for more information).  AIR SHIPMENT  Customs clearance takes about 7 days from receipt of all requirements before final delivery.

Diplomat's removals	<ul> <li>Original Bills of lading duly endorsed by the consignee, stamped by the applicable Embassy and stamped by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs.</li> <li>Form CC1 and/or CC2 and/or CC3 duly stamped by Customs, Ministry of Foreign Affairs and the applicable Embassy. Form CC1 applies to personal effects, CC2 to alcohol and CC3 to vehicles.</li> <li>Packing list stamped by the Embassy.</li> <li>Vehicle papers if applicable.</li> <li>Consignee's passport page (for an individual diplomat).</li> <li>Letters of authority from the Embassy, addressed to NCS (Nigeria Customs Service), NPF (Nigeria Police Force), SSS (State Security Service), NAFDAC(National Agency for Food &amp; Drug Administration and Control), NDLEA (Nigeria Drug Law Enforcement Agency), Plant Quarantine, DNI (Directorate of Naval Intelligence); duly endorsed and stamped by the Embassy, the applicable shipping company, etc.</li> </ul>	These are shipments belonging to Embassies and High commissions; or persons with diplomatic status in Nigeria. Such shipments are duty-free and are not physically examined by Customs here in Nigeria.	However, the Diplomatic mission must ensure that the diplomatic exemption document is transmitted via the official government channels to the port command where the shipment will be cleared. Failure to do this will result in delays which means demurrage and storage costs increase.

Restricted items	Firearms, ammunition and drugs are absolutely prohibited from import into Nigeria. Recreational weapons i.e. air rifles and guns are also prohibited irrespective of the fact that the owner has a licence in his home country.	Oustonis i Tesempuons	Remarks
Prohibited items	Purniture – H.S. Codes 9401.1000.00 – 9401.9000.99 and 9403.1000 – 9404.9000, but excluding Baby walkers, laboratory cabinets such as microscope table, fume cupboards, laboratory benches (9403), Stadium Chairs, height adjustments device, base sledge, seat frames and control mechanism, arm guide and head guides. Also excluded are; skeletal parts of furniture such as blanks, upholstered or unfinished part of metal, plastics, veneer, chair shell etc.  Brand new furniture is prohibited to be shipped to Nigeria in household goods shipments. If new furniture is found in a shipment, this will lead to the total seizure of the container as well as seizure of the whole consignment.  Also note that old and used furniture shipped in quantities larger than a set per room, will attract fines and duties/taxes from Nigeria Customs. Motor vehicles	<ul> <li>Original international passport of consignee.</li> <li>Original Resident permit/ green card (for non-Nigerians).</li> <li>Original registration card.</li> <li>Car's invoice.</li> <li>Certificate of ownership OBL showing chassis number, engine number, cylindrical power, age, brand and model of vehicle.</li> <li>Parking list.</li> <li>These information must not only be shown on the OBL, but must also be available on at least one of the official car documents provided (certificate of ownership, car title, car invoice, etc.).</li> </ul>	There will be duty payable on cars and new items, as advised by Customs. Used Motor Vehicles above {15} years from the year of manufacture are not allowed into the country. The log book and any other relevant vehicle papers will be required for Customs clearance at arrival.  Note that all imported goods are prohibited to be exported back including cars! However, in recent times the customs have been flexible and have allowed the export of motor vehicles.	Custom clearing takes 5 working days from receipts of all requirements before final delivery.

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
